



Navigation and Rapid Rehousing (RRH)

Acknowledgment

Rapid Rehousing is a time limited housing intervention designed to assist families with minor children in moving into stable housing as quickly as possible with the outcome of the family taking over full rental payments. Your family is being prioritized for navigation services. Your navigator is task with guiding you to stable housing and providing with you with resources and information about Rapid Rehousing.

Program Requirements for RRH:

- In order to be considered a family in RRH you **must** have minor child\children, 17 or under, in your household currently, or plan to be reunited with those children within 90 days of assignment to a RRH Case Manager.

*It has been noted that you may have one or more children currently not in your household that you've advised you have custody of. If approved for RRH you **must** have the minor child/children in your care within 90 days of assignment to a RRH Case Manager*

If you are unable comply with the above RRH requirements, the following will occur:

- If you **are housed** within 90 days of acceptance into RRH program and do not have your minor child/children visible and in your care then your RRH assistance payment will stop.
- If you **are not housed** within 90 days of acceptance into the RRH program and do not have your minor child/children visible and in your care the supportive services and housing search services may stop.
